Participation Requirements

Admission to the program can be granted if the requirements relating to residence status and university entrance qualification are met.

For the German course B1/B2

Applicants have to demonstrate knowledge of German as a foreign language at least at completed level A2.2 through a university-related placement test at TH Köln (written test and interview) and will be placed either in course B1.1 or B1.2.

After successfully passing the German B1 / B2 course, participants have completed a study-related level B2.1 or B2.2 and are therefore eligible for the German C1 course with DSH at TH Köln. It is not necessary to reapply for the course.


For the German course C1 with DSH

It is also possible to apply directly for the German course C1 with DSH after finishing successfully the German course B1/B2.




Course Cycle
